RULES AND CRITERIA FOR THE 2020/2021 DESIGN A FOURTH GRADE FOLDER CONTEST

- 1. Entries must be based on the theme "Fun Things to do Instead of Doing Drugs".
- 2. Students must work independently on their submission. Only one submission per student will be accepted.
- 3. <u>On the back of each artwork entry, include</u>: **student's first and last name, school name, school address and phone number and teacher's name.** *Submissions lacking this information will be disqualified.* (Some teachers find it easiest to print labels).
- 4. To meet folder printing standards, artwork submissions must meet the following criteria:
 - Only white, 8 1/2" x 11" copy paper may be used. Do not use construction or colored paper.
 - Design must be in portrait format only, not landscape.
 - Use crayons, pens, markers, and pencils. Any color is acceptable.
 - Please do not use glitter, "sparkle" glue, collages or other media. (They don't reproduce well.)
- 5. No copyrighted characters, images, corporate or otherwise (i.e., Nike, McDonalds) or celebrities may be used or inferred. This is very important. A simple way to explain this is to note that if they have seen it on television or in the movies, it cannot be used (i.e.— Pokemon, Disney characters, wrestlers, athletes, etc.). Any entry that uses a copyrighted character, image or celebrity will need to be disqualified.
- 6. We recommend limiting text to a simple drug-prevention slogan or saying. Too much writing can clutter the picture. The focus of the submission should be the artwork.

7. TEACHERS MUST INLCUDE THE ARTWORK SUBMISSION FORM WHEN SUBMITTING YOUR STUDENTS' ARTWORK ENTRIES.

Within these guidelines, students should rely on their own imaginations and be as creative and original as possible. We hope that this will be a positive learning experience for all involved and we look forward to seeing all of the submissions. Submissions must be mailed by December 7, 2020 to:
