Who can enter?

New Jersey students in grades 5th-8th

- Individual and Group entries are permitted no more than 10 students in a group.
- Parents of remote-learning students may submit an entry on their child's behalf.
- No copyrighted works allowed (names, images, music, etc.)
- MP4 files are preferred.
- Only those who are part of the group should appear in the video.
