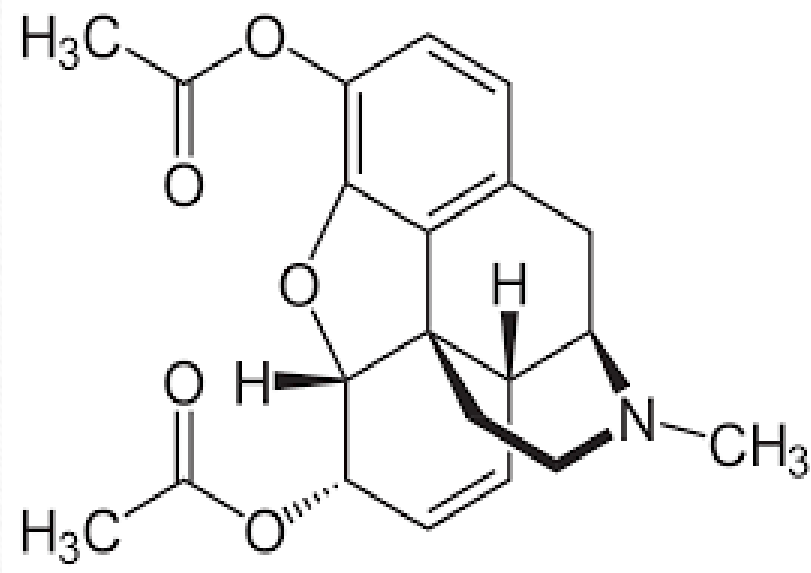

Overview

Saint Clare's Hospital

- -Inpatient Services located in Boonton, NJ
 - Detoxification Unit- 16 bed unit
 - Alcohol and Chemical Dependency Services (ACDS)
- -Two major outpatient sites: Denville NJ and Morris Plains NJ
- -Wellness and Recovery Center: Denville, NJ

Good News

- More people are accessing services
- 580 admissions to Detox unit (10% increase YTD)
- 615 admissions to ACDS IOP (Alcohol Chemical Dependency Services-Intensive Outpatient Program)- 20% increase since last month.
- Very qualified and committed staff
- 65% of admissions identify heroin or opioid as Primary Drug of Choice

Bad News

- Stigma
- Accessibility Issues
- Working in Silos
- Lack of Continuum of Services
- Absence of Wrap Around Services
- Absence of Medication Assisted Therapies (MAT)

....but there is hope

- Collaborative Effort
- Building Partnerships rather than competition
- Ownership of the Issue
- Hope 1-Ongoing collaboration from the Sheriff's Office, CARES (Center for Addiction and Recovery Services), Morris County DHS and multiple treatment providers.

- Treatment Program Networking
