



#KnockOutOpioidAbuseDay is Virtual this Year - Students Can Help Spread the Word

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Students can complete leadership and service hours by participating in #KnockOutOpioidAbuseDay by completing any or all of the activities below:

- Coordinate at School
 - Request school administration to share #KnockOutOpioidAbuse messages via email to all parents and on school website and social media.
 - Ask school administration to share a free substance use prevention video with parents. Sign-up for it here: drugfreenj.org/childbreakvideo
 - Ask Athletic Directors and Coaches to share the SOAP Initiative video with parents of student athletes. The video can be accessed here.

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- Coordinate in the Community
 - Invite municipal leaders to share a #KnockOutOpioidAbuse message with residents via email, website or on social media.
 - Ask municipal government leaders to issue a proclamation in support of #KnockOutOpioidAbuseDay
 - Ask faith leaders to share #KnockOutOpioidAbuse messages with their congregation in weekly services and via newsletters, social media and websites.
- Coordinate with Peers
 - Request that peers and fellow students share a #KnockOutOpioidAbuse Day message with family, friends, teachers and neighbors via email or social media.
 - Invite peers and fellow students to watch the New Jersey Shout Down Drugs High School Music concert @ shoutdowndrugs.com
