### **CONTEST GUIDELINES**

1. **Drawings must be in portrait format only. Landscape formats will be disqualified.**
  2. Entries must be based on the theme **"Fun Things to Do Instead of Doing Drugs"**. We recommend limiting text to a simple drug-prevention slogan or saying. The focus should be the artwork.
  3. Students must work independently on their submission. Only one submission per student. Students should rely on their own imaginations; all artwork must be completely original.
  4. **Not permitted:** No copyrighted images, logos, cartoon characters, celebrities, or famous athletes, etc. No sparkles or neon colors. No photos, clipart or other images may be inserted. **\*\*\*NO TRACING\*\*\*** Must be original artwork.
  5. **For traditional drawings on paper (Must submit by mail; see instructions above):**
    - Use white, 8 1/2" x 11" paper only.
    - Do not use construction or colored paper.
- For digital artwork (Must submit electronically; see upload instructions above):**
- Drawings created with a digital art creator application will be permitted. Please be aware that not all apps are free. **\*Teachers or parents should monitor any child who is utilizing a digital program.** *If using an app, be aware that some glitches could occur with personal devices that PDFNJ cannot be responsible for.*

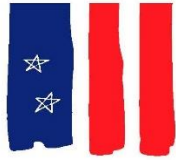
