Who can enter?

New Jersey students in grades 5th-8th

Deadline to Enter: March 27, 2026

***A \$1,000 prize will be awarded for the winning PSA**

All entries are judged by a panel on creativity, message content and ability to be produced. The winning PSA will be distributed across the tri-state area. The PSA will also be featured in PDFNJ's social media and peer-to-peer substance use messaging.

All participating students will receive a Certificate of Achievement.

Official Contest Rules:

- **Only those students who are part of the entry should appear in the video.**
- Individual and Group entries are permitted - no more than 10 students in a group.
- Parents of remote-learning and homeschooled students may submit on their child's behalf.
- No copyrighted works allowed in video (names, images, logos, music, etc.)
- Students' clothing should also not contain any copyrighted names, images, logos, etc.
